

Environmental policy

Our statement

Greenalia is committed to protection of the environment beyond legal and regulatory requirements and we will continually look for new ways to manage and reduce our environmental impact, assessing and monitoring the environmental risks.

Monitoring and improving our environmental performance are integral parts of our operations. In order to assure the environmental integrity of our projects, we adhere to the following principles and commit to them under the responsibility of the Organisation's managers:

We will comply with and exceed all relevant environmental legislation.

We will protect biodiversity by assessing our impact prior to any intervention, implementing prevention and mitigation measures and monitoring continuously.

We will only consider and engage contractors with certified environmental management systems for the construction works of all our projects and will monitor their environmental performance.

We will demonstrate transparency regarding the sustainability of the wood and forest products we purchase and sell by maintaining our current third-party certifications FSC and PEFC forestry certifications, as long as they both remain credible and respected.

We will employ management systems and procedures specifically designed to minimize the use of energy, water, hazardous materials, natural resources, the generation of greenhouse gas emissions and waste, promoting practices of recycling and reuse of materials.

We will continually seek opportunities to improve our environmental performance by establishing objectives and targets, measuring progress and reporting our results regularly, including possible breaches of this policy, in a transparent manner.

We will promote environmental responsibility among our employees and increase employee awareness and training; Internal training on the content of this procedure is provided

We will put in place remediation processes in case breaches of this policy occurs. The nature of these process will be discussed and decided on a case by case basis by the Organisation's Management and Sustainability Committee.

We will communicate our commitment to responsible environmental management my making this document publicly available in our website.
